

Creating a Web Photo Gallery

For this Lab you will create a Web Photo Gallery using the Automated Feature in Photoshop. It will be just like the exercise from the HOT book except that I want you to pick a different style. A style is the look and feel of the page. There are preset styles in Photoshop that you can choose from. The Lecture example used the Simple style, but there are also others such as Horizontal Blue and Gray, Horizontal Dark, Table, Vertical Frame, etc. The Resources disk that comes with the Photoshop application disks has other Web Photo Gallery templates too. Choose colors and information that you like but remember some styles do not allow you to change these. Get creative and try applying your own images to the gallery. If you absolutely cannot find your own images, use the images from the Photoshop Samples folder or stock images provided with Photoshop CS2.

SUMMARY

- 1) Create a Web Photo Gallery using a style of your choice
- 2) Use your information for the Banner
- 3) Use your own images or those from samples or stock
- 4) Pick Colors that you want
- 5) Use a copyright if you like or any other info
- 6) Save your work by clicking OK. The documents will be saved in a folder you specify.
- 7) Turn in this LAB in one of two ways:
 - Method 1 – post the Web Photo Gallery to your ISP and send the webpage or URL
 - Method 2 – attach all your files zipped: index.htm, contents of folders (Images, Thumbnails, and Pages)
